

The Legacy of Westway CT's involvement in the 2012 Olympics lives on as we were asked to provide Accessible shuttle services for the Rugby World Cup, ensuring that everyone could get to see the games whatever their level of mobility.

Westway CT was part of the team that has developed a tool kit in order to calculate the social value contribution that the provision of CT can bring. We have developed a method that will measure all the same outputs across different CT's across the capital and we plan to present our collective findings in the future. You may ask what we mean by Social Value..... Well in short it's measuring the money that would have to be spent if CT did not provide the services we do. So looking at our calculations for Westway CT ... they work out at the moment at a saving to statutory agencies of something in the region of £21,000 a week translating into over £1 M a year. #WhyCTMatters

In addition to this we are grateful to our Funders for supporting us with the core funding and are proud to say that for every £1 we receive in Grant we generate a further £7

Putting all this together with our other income generating activities through Social Enterprise we believe we are offering really good value for money.

Quality is at the heart of everything we do and we are aware that we need to be mindful and put in place the policies and backroom procedures that ensure we run smoothly and safely.

We have been refining and adapting our systems and procedures in order to achieve this and earlier this year we were awarded Transport for London's FORS Bronze award a recognition that we meet TfL's criteria for fleet operators.

We continue to be involved in the wider CT network and work collaboratively with our peers in other boroughs.

Westway CT hosted the **London Strategic CT Forum** again for the third time. This event brings together CT's from all over London to look at similar issues facing us all to discuss and look at ways we can work together more effectively and how we can share good practice and learn from each other.

In the wider context Westway CT is one of the Leading Community Transport Providers in London. It's in a great position to continue to serve its many Individual and Group members, way into the future.

We are enjoying working with our partners in the statutory agencies and sharing the benefits and outcomes that this brings.

We have a great team that will rise to future challenges we will continue to be innovative, listen to the needs of our users and ensure that we deliver solutions that are not only affordable but also sustainable.

We will build on our ethical way of delivering Social Enterprise, Promote Citizenship through volunteering and continue to provide opportunity to ensure equal access to all it serves.

Westway CT is a special organisation to be involved with and this is borne out by Pepe and Jose's lengthy involvement. 25 years is quite a milestone and I feel privileged and humbled to have been involved as director for the last 14 years.
