



Minibus Emergency Evacuation Training Course Content

What the course involves

The course involves some classroom based training which provides the skills and information needed when evacuating a vehicle fire. There will also be a practical element where trainees will be observed participating in several evacuations of a passenger carrying vehicle, both with and without the presence of smoke simulation, conducted in a safe environment in which to practice these principles. Trainees will also have the opportunity to role-play as passengers with disabilities or other factors that may delay or complicate an evacuation.

The objectives of the emergency & evacuation course are;

- How to recognise common causes of fire
- How to reduce the risk of vehicle fires starting
- When and how to use a fire extinguisher
- How to safely evacuate a vehicle using 'GOLDEN RULES' of evacuation

Trainees will receive a Certificate of Attendance on completion of the training.
